Opportunities are available for undergraduate pre-health professions students to job shadow within the Kirksville medical and dental clinics of the Northeast Missouri Health Council (NMHC). To qualify, students must:

- attend a shadow training session,
- provide documentation of required immunizations, and
- demonstrate understanding of key HIPAA, OSHA, and professionalism principals.

Training is coordinated by the NEMO Area Health Education Center (NEMO AHEC).
